Lulu Auditions FAQ

How early do I need to arrive prior to my scheduled audition?

Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes prior to your audition time.

What should my child wear?

The character's costume is simple denim with a t-shirt, so participants can wear whatever makes them comfortable. The audition will require running; therefore, children should wear appropriate shoes to run in safely.

What do we need to bring?

Please bring a current photo and resume, if available. When your audition time is confirmed, you will also receive several documents to review and sign and bring to the audition with you.

Do I get to watch my child audition?

Children will be brought into the audition room with VTA staff. Parents will be asked to wait outside for the 5-minute audition.

How long will the audition take?

Each audition is expected to take approximately 5 minutes; however, it may take some time to get to your child. Please be prepared to stay at the audition for approximately 1 hour.

Where do I go when I arrive?

The **PNC ARTS ANNEX** is located on the corner of Second and Ludlow Streets in downtown Dayton (46 West Second Street). Parking is available at the Arts Garage, also on the corner of Second and Ludlow Streets. It's easy-in on either Ludlow or Second Streets. Also, keep in mind parking on the street downtown is free on weekends.

Please check in with a VTA staff member upon arrival.

Who decides which actresses will be cast?

All casting decisions are made by the company representing **WAITRESS**.

If my child is cast, what is the expectation?

Your child should be available June 25-30, 2019 for performances of **WAITRESS**. The part appears in the finale, so children should be prepared to be at the Schuster Center until at least 10:30 p.m. (Tues.- Sat), 4:30 p.m. for matinees (Sat. and Sun.) and 10 p.m. (Sun.). Additional information will be provided to those selected by the company of **WAITRESS**.

What if my child cannot make one of the scheduled performances but would still like to audition?

Each actress should be prepared to step in at any of the eight scheduled performances. Any conflicts should be disclosed at the audition.

When will we be notified of casting?

The production office will contact the parent or guardian by phone or email within two weeks of the audition. The names will also be announced on the Victoria Theatre Association Facebook page and website (victoriatheatre.com)
